Check your itinerary and what your lodging or tour provides before packing. Pack light, plan to rewear or wash clothing, and leave room for Maui-made finds.

Everyday Maui Clothing

- ☐ 2 or 3 swimsuits
- ☐ Lightweight shirts and tank tops
- ☐ Shorts or breathable bottoms
- ☐ 1 casual evening outfit
- ☐ Beach cover-up
- ☐ Sleepwear and undergarments
- ☐ Light sweater or windbreaker
- ☐ Long pants or leggings
- ☐ Sandals or flip-flops
- ☐ Comfortable walking shoes

Beach And Sun Essentials

- ☐ Water shoes, if your plans require them
- ☐ Sun hat
- ☐ Polarized sunglasses
- ☐ Mineral sunscreen (zinc oxide and/or titanium dioxide)
- ☐ Rash guard or UPF sun shirt
- ☐ Quick-dry towel
- ☐ Reusable water bottle
- ☐ Small beach bag or daypack

Weather And Adventure Gear

- ☐ Dry bag or waterproof pouch
- ☐ Light rain jacket
- ☐ Warm Haleakalā jacket or fleece
- ☐ Beanie and light gloves
- ☐ Trail or hiking shoes
- ☐ Insect repellent
- ☐ Soft cooler or insulated bag
- ☐ Reusable shopping bag

Health, Technology, And Travel

- ☐ Personal medications
- ☐ Motion-sickness remedy
- ☐ Mini first-aid kit
- ☐ Phone and charging cable
- ☐ Portable power bank (carry-on only)
- ☐ Waterproof phone case or action camera
- ☐ ID and reservation confirmations
- ☐ Credit or debit card and some cash
- ☐ Wet-clothes bag

Snorkeling And Boat Tour

- ☐ Wear your swimsuit under your clothes
- ☐ Towel
- ☐ Dry change of clothes
- ☐ Hat and sunglasses
- ☐ Waterproof phone case or camera protection
- ☐ Credit card or phone for harbor parking
- ☐ Seasickness remedy, if needed
- ☐ Personal medication

Maui Snorkeling provides standard gear, flotation, mineral sunscreen, food and drinks by tour, shade, and onboard restrooms.

Road To Hāna

- ☐ Light rain jacket
- ☐ Secure walking or trail shoes
- ☐ Water and snacks
- ☐ Motion-sickness supplies
- ☐ Phone charger and power bank
- ☐ Offline directions
- ☐ Dry clothes
- ☐ Small first-aid kit
- ☐ Reservation confirmations

Keep valuables out of sight when the vehicle is parked.

Haleakalā

- ☐ Long pants
- ☐ Closed shoes and warm socks
- ☐ Warm sweater or fleece
- ☐ Wind-resistant outer jacket
- ☐ Beanie and light gloves
- ☐ Water
- ☐ ID and sunrise reservation, when required

Summit conditions can be near or below freezing even when the coast is warm.

Hiking And Waterfalls

- ☐ Trail shoes with useful grip
- ☐ Light rain jacket
- ☐ Water and snacks
- ☐ Sun protection
- ☐ Insect repellent
- ☐ Small first-aid kit
- ☐ Offline map or downloaded directions

Avoid streams and waterfall pools during heavy rain or flash-flood conditions.

Farms And Upcountry

- ☐ Closed-toe shoes
- ☐ Light layers
- ☐ Rain jacket
- ☐ Sun protection
- ☐ Reusable water bottle
- ☐ Clothes that can handle dirt or animal hair

Rainy Days

- ☐ Light rain jacket
- ☐ Secure walking shoes
- ☐ Dry pouch for electronics
- ☐ Extra dry shirt
- ☐ Phone charger
- ☐ Offline directions

Avoid brown or murky ocean water after heavy rain.

Families

- ☐ Swim diapers, when needed
- ☐ Extra clothes in the day bag
- ☐ Familiar snacks
- ☐ Child medications
- ☐ Sun hat and rash guard
- ☐ Small comfort item
- ☐ Books, games, tablet, or headphones
- ☐ Reusable wet-clothes bag
- ☐ Light hoodie

Skip Or Rent Instead

- ☐ Non-mineral sunscreen
- ☐ Too much formal clothing
- ☐ Several pairs of heavy shoes
- ☐ Bulky beach equipment your lodging provides
- ☐ A full snorkel set for a guided tour
- ☐ A full-face snorkel mask for Maui Snorkeling tours
- ☐ Irreplaceable jewelry and valuables

Condo Or Resort

- ☐ Confirm towels and beach gear
- ☐ Confirm toiletries and hair dryer
- ☐ Pack or buy laundry supplies, if needed
- ☐ Pack or buy groceries and food-storage items for a condo
